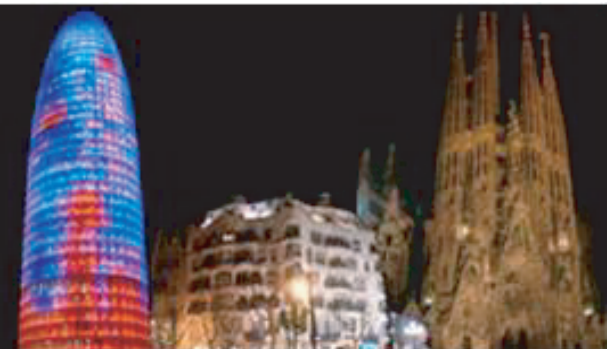




ICC on Genomic Imprinting and Beyond 2011
